



Canada Winter Games 2023 Application

Nordiq Alberta is advertising for coaching positions to fill the staff requirements for the [2023 Canada Winter Games](#) (CWG) taking place in Prince Edward Island February 26 to March 5, 2023.

Any staff listed as Head coach on the official registration form must be fully certified under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Competition stream, Development context or Level 4.

Assistant coaches and Para Nordic designated coaches on the official registration form must be certified under the National Coaching Certification Program Competition Stream Development context (Trained status), or Level 4.

The team will include Para-Nordic athletes; thus the additional Para-Nordic coach must have completed NCCP-CCI AWAD level training.

The 2023 CWG will include 12 able bodied athletes with 6 males and 6 females and there will be the addition of 4 Para Nordic athletes with at least 1 male and 1 female. The total team size will be 16 athletes with the athletes and coaching staff working together as Team Alberta.

Nordiq Alberta is seeking the following positions for the Canada Winter Games:

Coaching Staff

- **Head Coach: 1 Coach**

The head coach on the official registration form must be certified under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Competition stream, Development context (Certified status), or Level 4 fully certified in the old NCCP in Cross Country Ski. These coaches must be so certified no later than 90 days before the opening of the Games (November 20, 2022).

- **Assistant Coach: 1 Coach**

Assistant Coaches and the Para-Nordic designated coach on the official registration form must be certified under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Competition stream, Development context (Trained status), or Level 4 fully certified in the old NCCP in Cross Country Ski. These coaches must be certified / trained not later than 90 days before the opening of the Games (November 20, 2022).



- **Para-Nordic Coach: 1 Coach**

Para-Nordic designated coaches on the official registration form must be certified under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Competition stream, Development context (Trained status), or Level 4 fully certified in the old NCCP in Cross Country Ski. These coaches must be certified / trained not later than 90 days before the opening of the Games (November 20, 2022).

Notes for coaches:

- Coaches registered in the Canada Games electronic registration system must be Nordiq Canada NCCP Competition Coaching Development (CCD) certified.
- Para-Nordic coaches must be Nordiq Canada NCCP Competition Coaching Development (CCD) certified in the Para Context.
- Coaches must be so certified no later than 90 days prior to the opening ceremony (November 20, 2022).
- Please note that “NCCP Competition-Development Certified, Not Renewed” does not qualify under the coaching standards for the 2023 Canada Winter Games.

Team Staff

- **Team Manager: 1 position**

The Team Manager will be responsible for the administration of the CWG team. The Manager will work with the Head Coach and AB Mission staff to provide support for the team. NCCP training is an asset but not mandatory.

- **Wax Technician: 1 position**

To take the lead on providing wax and technical support of the CWG athlete's equipment. The wax technician will need previous experience in providing testing procedures, wax application and equipment inventory for teams. The wax technician will work with the Head coach in developing a procedure for providing wax support for the CWG Team.
